DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN HANOI

Upon arrival at Noi Bai International Terminal in Hanoi, you will be warmly received and assisted with your transfer to the designated hotel. After settling in, a period of relaxation can be enjoyed at the hotel. The night will be spent in Hanoi.



DAY 2: CITY TOUR IN HANOI (Breakfast, Lunch)

Commence the day with a hearty breakfast. The day's itinerary unfolds with a comprehensive City Tour in the heart of Vietnam's capital. Highlights include an exterior view of Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, an exploration of Uncle Ho's Stilt House, a visit to **Temple of Literature** (known as the country's first university, established in 1075) and the iconic **One Pillar Pagoda**. A traditional Hanoi-style lunch will be savored, followed by a delightful **Cyclo ride** that meanders through the charming Old Quarter.

Lunch at local restaurant with speciality food of Hanoi. Enjoy drink at Hoa Xa café – Long Bien Train Station (budget 70.000vnd/pax).

Later, proceed to the **Temple of Jade Mountain**, Tran Quoc Pagoda and the remains of Hanoi Citadel, each of which has been recognized as UNESCO heritage sites. The evening promises a cultural treat with the captivating Water Puppet Show. The day culminates with an overnight stay in Hanoi.

DAY 3: HANOI – CRUISE ON HA LONG BAY (Breakfast/On-board Lunch/On-board Dinner)

Commence the day with a satisfying breakfast. The itinerary proceeds with a departure to Ha Long, where upon arrival, you will check in on board. The cruise commences, guiding the travelers through the remarkable islets that define the renowned Ha Long Bay, famed for its enchanting karst landscapes and intricate caves. This exceptional site is well-deserving of its UNESCO World Heritage recognition. Lunch will be enjoyed on board, offering an opportunity to savor traditional Vietnamese cuisine during the cruise. Throughout the journey, there will be a chance to experience the local flavors. An option to ride punts, gliding through a sea tunnel into the Luon abyss, presents itself. Moreover, a chance to swim in the crystalline waters on Ti Top Island is offered, granting panoramic views of the bay from its summit. As the day winds down, a



sumptuous dinner will be served on board, providing a satisfying culinary experience. The night is spent on board, in the midst of the captivating beauty of Ha Long Bay.

DAY 4: HA LONG – HANOI – FLIGHT TO HUE (On-board Breakfast/On-board Brunch)

There is an opportunity to engage in a morning Tai Chi Exercise session on board the ship, invigorating the body and mind. Following this, an on-board breakfast will be served. The cruise continues with a visit to the captivating Sung Sot Cave, revealing the geological wonders of the area. Brunch is provided on board, ensuring a delightful culinary experience while surrounded by the stunning scenery.

As the day progresses, the afternoon entails disembarkation from the ship and the itinerary progresses to Noi Bai airport for a flight to Hue.

Upon arrival at Hue Airport, a transfer will be arranged to the designated hotel. The night will be spent in Hue, soaking in the historical and cultural essence of the city.

DAY 5: HUE – SIGHTSEEING EXPLORATION (Breakfast/Lunch)



Commence the day with a satisfying breakfast. Embark on a boat trip to explore the serene beauty of Thien Mu Pagoda. Following this, a visit to the Royal Citadel awaits, encompassing the Purple Forbidden City and the distinguished royal altars of the Nguyen Dynasty. A delightful lunch will be enjoyed at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, the journey continues with a visit

to the remarkable Minh Mang Royal Tomb, a site steeped in history and architectural splendor. The night will be spent in Hue, allowing you immerse yourself in the historical treasures and royal heritage of this captivating city.

DAY 6: TRAIN "CENTRAL HERITAGE CONNECTION" ROUTE HUE TO DA NANG – HOI AN (Breakfast/Lunch)



Commence the day with a hearty breakfast. Free at your leisure

A delectable lunch will be savored at a local restaurant, providing a culinary interlude.

Around 13:00 Pm, transfer to Hue Train station for the train trip to Da Nang -

Train HD3 Hue 14:25 Pm – Da Nang 17:40

Pm. The travel time for each trip is 3 hours, the train passes through Hai Van pass, you



can admire the majestic natural scenery. You can catch the sunrise on Lang Co Bay - one of the beautiful bays of the country

Upon arrival at Da Nang, you will be transferred to Hoi An. The journey continues to the charming Hoi An, partake in a walking tour that includes visits to **Tan Ky Old House, Fujian Assembly Hall**, the iconic **Japanese Covered Bridge**, and a traditional market within the historic Hoi An Ancient Town. The night unfolds in Hoi An, allowing you to immerse yourself in the cultural richness and architectural marvels of this enchanting town.

DAY 7: Hoi An - Da Nang - Flight To Ho Chi Minh City (Breakfast, Lunch)

Free at leisure until transfer to Da Nang Airport for a flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival at Ho Chi Minh City Airport, a transfer will be arranged to the hotel. The night will be spent in Saigon, soaking in the night life essence of the city.

DAY 8: CU CHI TUNNELS – DISCOVER HO CHI MINH CITY (Breakfast, Lunch)



Indulge in a hearty breakfast to kick-start your day. The morning offers leisurely moments for you to unwind and explore at your own pace. An optional excursion is available for those interested in exploring the renowned **Cu Chi Underground Tunnels**, a historically significant site. As the afternoon unfolds, return to the vibrant Ho Chi Minh City.

Engage in a concise City Tour, In the late

afternoon, engage in a brief yet insightful City Tour. This tour encompasses visits to prominent landmarks including the **Opera House, Central Post Office** and the bustling **Ben Thanh Central Market**. Retire for the night in the dynamic and vibrant ambiance of Ho Chi Minh City, fully immersing yourself in its cultural and historical offerings.

DAY 9: SAI GON - MEKONG DELTA EXCURSION (My Tho – Thoi Son – Tan Thach Canal – Ben Tre – Can Tho) (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Leaving the hustle and bustle of Ho Chi Minh City and start your trip to depart for My Tho, the town lies on the left side of the Mekong River.

Then boarding the sampan and cruising down the river around the four beautiful islands known as **Dragon, Unicorn, Phoenix and Tortoise islands.**

Stop over at Thoi Son (Unicorn Island), go walking around country lane and seeing orchards, enjoy tropical fruits, folk song music which performed by the local people.



Riding a hand-rowed sampan through the narrow canal and treat yourself in the beauty of the countryside, visit the family business, visit honey-bee farm, enjoy honey tea and coconut candy workshop.

Enjoy a boat ride through **Tan Thach canal** in Ben Tre to explore the peaceful waterways and discover the daily life of local people.

Have lunch at local restaurant. Afterwards, enjoy a **horse-cart ride** through the village roads for a closer look at the everyday life of the local people.

Return to My Tho and transfer to Can Tho
for hotel check-in.Overnight in Can Tho.



DAY 10: CAI RANG FLOATING MARKET– SAIGON (Breakfast)



Start the morning with an early pick-up from your Can Tho hotel.

Board a traditional wooden boat and cruise along the Mekong's tributaries to visit the famous **Cai Rang Floating Market**, where the city comes alive with the bustling rhythm of the "boat people" trading tropical fruits and local specialties.

Before heading back, stop at a local hủ tiếu (rice noodle) workshop for a hands-on look at traditional noodle-making - a true taste of Mekong Delta life.

Return to hotel then transfer back to Ho Chi Minh City.

DAY 11: SAIGON DEPARTURE (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free for leisure till time to the airport for departure, carrying with the memories and experiences of an enriching and diverse journey.
